<u>Campgrounds -</u> Soda Butte and Colter Campgrounds are open in the Custer Gallatin National Forest. Island, Beartooth, and Crazy Creek Campgrounds are open in the Shoshone National Forest.

**Beartooth Pass, Hwy 212 Construction** - Beginning July 7, U.S. 212 will be closed at night between milepost 22.8 (just west of Ghost Creek) and 27.4 (just west of Beartooth Lake Campground). This will continue throughout the summer until further notice. The closure will be implemented Monday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. During this period, no traffic will be allowed through the project site. There will be no overnight closures on Friday, Saturday, Sunday nights. In the daytime, motorists should expect delays up to 30-minutes, Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. There is one-way traffic through the construction site, controlled by a pilot car and temporary traffic signals at each end.

<u>Construction on Chief Joseph Hwy 296</u> - Slide Repair including grading, bituminous pavement surfacing, drilled shaft foundations and miscellaneous work on WYO 296 beginning at RM 32.50 for approximately 0.2 miles. One lane detour with traffic signals. Up to 20 minute delays. Gravel roadway. Beginning June 22, 2020 - June 30, 2021.

<u>Other Road Construction/Closures</u> - The road between Tower-Roosevelt and Chittenden Rd is completely closed until May 2022. Fishing Bridge to Indian Pond, expect delays.
